To ensure a safe, fair, and positive experience for all participants, coaches are expected to uphold the highest standards of sportsmanship and integrity throughout the tournament.

By participating in the 20th Annual Mother's Day Tournament, all coaches agree to the following:

1. Respect for Officials and Tournament Staff

- Coaches must treat all referees, tournament staff, volunteers, and opposing teams with respect.
- Disputes must be handled calmly and through appropriate channels. Arguing with officials or tournament staff will not be tolerated.

2. Positive Coaching Environment

- Coaches are responsible for creating a positive and safe environment for their players.
- Yelling at or belittling players, officials, or opponents is strictly prohibited.
- Foul language or aggressive behavior from coaches will result in immediate action.

3. Sideline Conduct

- Coaches must remain within the designated coaching area during games.
- Only rostered coaches are allowed on the sidelines.

4. Sportsmanship and Role Modeling

- Coaches should model good sportsmanship at all times.
- Any attempt to manipulate the score, encourage dirty play, or undermine the integrity of the game will result in removal.

5. Adherence to Game Rules

- All teams must follow the tournament rules as outlined in the rules provided.
- Coaches are responsible for ensuring that their players understand and abide by the rules.
